CONCORD ROAD RAIL CROSSING DEDICATED AND OPENING TODAY

York, PA – The Concord Road Rail Crossing was officially dedicated on Thursday, August 23, 2007 at 5:30 p.m. with a Ribbon Cutting Ceremony.

Members of the Springettsbury Township Board of Supervisors, as well the York County Commissioners, who were strong supporters of the project, gathered to cut the ribbon and dedicate the new rail crossing.

Mr. William Schenck, Chairman of the Springettsbury Township Board of Supervisors, stated that the road will open Friday, August 24, 2007 at 5:00 p.m., and that the only remaining improvements are sidewalks and streetlights along the roadway. These are expected to be completed by the end of September 2007.
