2006 BUDGET

York, PA – Springettsbury Township Board of Supervisors are pleased to announce that there is no increase in the 2006 municipal tax rate.

The Township Manager, Township staff and Board of Supervisor's held Work Sessions throughout the months of October and November in order to prepare the 2006 Budget for adoption on December 8, 2005, at the regularly scheduled meeting. This budget focuses on meeting key Township priorities, including street maintenance/improvements, completing the Comprehensive Plan and other strategic planning initiatives, while preparing the organization to meet the ever changing needs of the community and regulatory requirements through aggressive training programs for maximum utilization of the Townships information systems.

The Township will be undertaking several Capital Improvement projects in 2006, which include an accelerated sidewalk and road maintenance program and the renovations of the police pistol range. The average Springettsbury Township tax payer bill, home assessment \$100,000, will pay an average of \$87.00 in local taxes for 2006. This reflects the impact of the county reassessment, which was \$1,500,000,000 in 2005 and is \$1,900,000,000 for 2006.
