On Wednesday, April 29, 2009 the Springettsbury Township Police Department responded to the Wachovia Bank, located at 50 Haines Road regarding a report of a robbery in progress.

Preliminary investigation revealed that a bearded black male described as being late 20's/early 30's, approximately 5'5" wearing a black jacket, black pants, black white sox baseball cap entered the bank and handed a teller a note demanding cash.

After receiving an undisclosed amount of cash the subject exited the bank and fled the area.

On 5/11/09 at 2:27 PM Springettsbury Township Police Officers responded to PNC Bank, 2430 E. Market St., for the report of a bank robbery. The actor exited the bank prior to police arrival. On arrival bank employees advised that a black male entered the bank and handed the teller a note demanding money. The subject obtained an undisclosed amount of money and exited the bank.

The subject is described as a black male, twenty to thirty years of age, 5'5", medium build, wearing a black baseball hat, sun glasses, and a blue polo style shirt.

On Thursday, May 21, 2009 the Springettsbury Township Police Department obtained arrest warrants for Corey Richard Horne, age 40 of the 900 block of North Ashburton Street Baltimore, MD after he was identified by a Baltimore County Police Detective as a result of the photo released through the media.

Horne has been charged with two (2) counts each of Robbery; Theft By Unlawful Taking; and Receiving Stolen Property as a result of these incidents.

Horne is currently in the custody of the Baltimore County authorities as a result of failure to appear warrants stemming from prior bank robbery charges. York County authorities have issued a detainer for Horne who will be extradited at a later time.
