FIRST COMPREHENSIVE PLAN PUBLIC FORUM A SUCCESS

York, PA – Springettsbury Township held a public forum at Central York Middle School on April 26, 2005 to review draft goals and objectives developed by the Comprehensive Plan Committee (CPC).

Over 100 Township residents attended the forum and participated in one hour break-out group exercises that included topics such as transportation, open space/agricultural needs, housing, town center, community character, and economic development. The groups then reported their results to the CPC, proposing strategies and solutions to any issues that their group may have discovered through their review of the draft goals and objectives. Results of the break-out sessions will be finalized by consultant Kise Straw & Kolodner (KSK) and incorporated into a new set of goals and objectives that will drive future public forums, and assist in the completion of the Township's new Comprehensive Plan.

Springettsbury Township thanks Central York Middle School for allowing the CPC to hold their first public forum at the facility and also thanks all residents who participated in the forum. The CPC meets on the fourth Tuesday of each month at 6:00 p.m. All citizens are encouraged to attend the meetings.
