Springettsbury Sewer Main Break

York, PA – Springettsbury Township was made aware of a possible sewer force main break along a tributary to Kreutz Creek behind Fincor and the new Kinsley building on East Market Street on July 3, 2005. After investigating the break, the Township authorized an emergency contract for repairing the line.

Springfield Contractors, the Director of Wastewater Treatment, and five members of the Public Works Department worked throughout the evening of July 3rd to replace the damaged pipe. The repairs were completed by 10:00 a.m. on July 4, 2005.

The Department of Environmental Protection and all appropriate agencies were notified of the break. The excavation will be surrounded by orange fencing until it can be properly filled in on July 6, 2005.

The Township thanks Mark Hodgkinson, Director of Wastewater Treatment, our employees who worked at the site, and Springfield Contractors for completing their repairs expeditiously.

The Township is reviewing the possible causes of the break.
