York, PA- Officials representing townships of the second class in York County will convene Thursday, November 10, 2005 at the White Rose Room, York Fairgrounds/Expo Center for their Annual County Convention.

The purpose of the annual convention is to provide township officials with up-to-date information to help them better serve their residents and to give them an opportunity to exchange ideas on local government.

The convention will feature a wide range of speakers, including James Wheeler, director of environmental affairs; manager, CDL programs of the Pennsylvania State Association of Township Supervisors. Wheeler will talk about legislation affecting townships of the second class, association programs and services for townships, and issues of major importance to townships and their residents.

The meeting will also feature performances by Kennard-Dale High School Men's Quartet and Brass Quintet. The Quartet has a long-standing tradition in their area, frequently performing for school and community functions, while the Quintet is relatively new. The Men's Quartet will be accompanied by Mr. Carl Barr and the Brass Quartet, comprised of trumpets, trombone, tuba and horn will be led by Mr. Matthew Barr.

The State Association of Township Supervisors represents Pennsylvania's 1,456 townships of the second class, 32 of which are located in York County.
