Springettsbury Township Receives Safe Routes to Schools Funding

York, PA – Springettsbury Township was awarded \$426,006 in Safe Routes to Schools funding on February 15, 2005 by Governor Edward Rendell on the steps of the York City Hall. The Township applied for the funding in July of 2004 under Governor Rendell's Home Town Streets and Safe Routes to Schools program in order to build sidewalks in the area of the new Central York High School, East York Elementary School, York Suburban Middle School, and St. Johns Lutheran Church School. The City of York, Delta Borough, and Dillsburg Borough were also recipients of the Home Town Streets and Safe Routes to School grant program.

The Township has been working with Dr. Estep and Central York High School to develop the project, as 5130 feet of sidewalk will be placed in the vicinity of Central York High School alone. The funding will allow the Township to provide safe routes for students to walk to school, with a total of 14,810 feet of sidewalk to be placed in the area of the four schools.

Springettsbury Township thanks Governor Rendell, as he continues to strengthen our communities through programs like Home Town Streets and Safe Routes to Schools.
