Federal Funding For Concord Road

York, PA- Springettsbury Township received notice that \$500,000 of Federal funds has been earmarked for Concord Road improvements in Springettsbury Township. The funds will be used to provide the first new traffic corridor in fifteen years. The new corridor will help resolve traffic congestion, while encouraging economic development in the area.

Concord Road intersects directly with Route 24 (Mt. Zion Road). Mt. Zion Road is a heavily traveled road that Springettsbury Township Board of Supervisors have identified as needing improvement for over 15 years. Much development has occurred along this corridor with little improvements made to the key intersections. This funding will allow improvements to address significant existing conditions and greatly improve mobility through the Township's road network.

Springettsbury Township Board of Supervisors thank Pennsylvania Congressmen and Senators for their support of Concord Road improvements, as it has been a long term project for the Board.
