**MEETING MINUTES

In a continuation of the discussion and review of the current trash contract in preparation for the new contract the committee offered suggestions for additions that could be made to the contract. In an effort to try to increase the amount of materials that are being recycled one suggestion that was made was to contact all contract bidders to see if there are more items that can be recycled such as plastic bottles of all shapes and not just the small neck bottles which are the only type bottles currently being accepted for recycling.

It was then discussed whether there should be provided for residents a larger size toter for recycling that would be done on a voluntary basis and for which those residents wanting the larger size toter would pay an extra cost. If that were to be included in the contract it was discussed whether the size of the toter should be specified as a 96 gallon toter or should that size be left open.

The date of May 8, 2012 was set for the next meeting.
