**MEETING MINUTES**

**November 10, 2015**

**ATTENDEES**

Charles Stuhre, Chairman; Ron DiAngelo, William Greenawalt; Penny Dellinger; Abby Gibb, Township Representative.

The Committee met and chose a new Committee Chairman, Charles Stuhre. Next up for discussion was where township residents can take items for recycling that are not permitted for curbside recycling nor permitted in the trash such as bricks, drywall, broken concrete and how township residents can be informed of where to take these items. It was determined that the York County Solid Waste Authority would be a good source to locate those facilities and they will be contacted. After locations are determined those companies will be contacted to see if they will allow township residents to take those materials to their locations and the legalities of posting specific drop off company names in the township newsletter will be determined. The same procedure will be done in locating places for residents to drop off yard waste from downed trees, etc. during off times when that material can't be placed curbside for pickup. It was noted that the York County Solid Waste Authority does accept small amounts that are then chipped.

The next item for discussion was the fact that some of Penn Waste's trucks aren't pushing empty trash totes completely off the road, one example being on Mt. Zion Road, and the concern is that it is a hazard for drivers on that road. Penn Waste will be informed about this issue.

The Committee finally discussed a change in meet times throughout the year, changing from every other month to meeting on a quarterly basis which will enable coordination with the township newsletter deadlines. It was noted that meetings during new trash contract preparation years will be more frequent as the need arises to meet.

The date of January 12, 2016, at the time of 6:00 p.m. has been set for the next meeting.
