MEETING MINUTES

April 12, 2016

The Committee met to discuss the e-cycling update. The York County Solid Waste Authority will again offer electronics recycling to Township residents Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday of each week from 3 pm-6:30 pm thru the end of this year. YCSWA is seeking another company that will take this material so that the program can be continued in 2017.

Next the Committee discussed the disposal of construction material and the options available for residents. Non-burnable material such as concrete, bricks, drywall, roofing shingles, etc. is accepted at Modern Landfill. There will be a fee per ton so several residents can possibly combine materials to meet the ton amount.

The question as to whether a one-time spring cleanup collection could be re-instated was raised. This was a program that used to be done but due to the cost was discontinued and it has been determined that the high cost would prohibit re-instating it.

Lastly, the committee discussed some problems that are occurring within the Township regarding Penn Waste's collection of trash and recyclables. Some trash and recycling are being left out in the street after being emptied as well as some not being overturned properly so that they don't blow around. Penn Waste will be notified of this and hopefully this can be corrected.

The date of Tuesday, July 12, 2016 at the time of 6:00 p.m. has been set for the next meeting.
