**MEETING MINUTES**

**January 12, 2016**

The Committee met to review the Township Newsletter Recycling page layout. The Penn Waste Acceptable Items column was deleted to create space for future information and articles. All items that belong in the regular trash will be listed. Special Hasmat dates will be noted and also listed will be locations where Township residents can take scrap metal, motor oil and construction waste. Modern Landfill charges \$35.00 for up to each 1000 pounds and York County Solid Waste Authority will take up to each 320 pounds for a \$10.00 charge.

Next the Committee set meeting dates for each year. They are the second Tuesdays of the months of January, April, July, and October.

The Committee then discussed the E-recycling suspension announced by the York County Solid Waste Authority at the end of December 2015 due to problems finding outlets for the collected electronic devices which per Act 108, the "Covered Device Recycling Act" requires collection and recycling of such electronics as televisions, desktop and laptop computers and computer peripherals. Authorities suggest that the law needs to be revised so that the recycling can be sustainable. Pennsylvania State Representative Keith Gillespie is co-sponsoring a revision to this Act in the state legislature.

Lastly, the committee discussed and suggested that committee members write short articles possibly with related web site links for more information for Township residents that would be edited by Abby Gibb for future Township newsletters. Topics about recycling and the environment were suggested.

The date of Tuesday, April 12, 2016, at the time of 6:00 p.m. has been set for the next meeting.
