1. CALL TO ORDER

SWOMLEY Chairman Swomley called the Public Hearing to order. He stated the purpose of this hearing is a Request to Transfer a Restaurant Liquor License.

2. NEW BUSINESS

A. Request to Transfer Restaurant Liquor License R-20623 to Two Farms, Inc., d/b/a Royal Farms, 3401 Concord Road, York, Pennsylvania

JORDAN Jonathan Jordan, Attorney for Royal Farms provided testimony as to Royal Farms' request. They are constructing a new convenience store at 3401 Concord Road and have agreed to assume the purchase of a Liquor License from Two Brothers Pizza from Newberry Township. They sought approval to transfer the

license into Springettsbury Township. Mr. Jordan continued his testimony, which is summarized:

- Royal Farms is a family-owned business based in Baltimore; operates 187 convenience stores, three in Springettsbury hold liquor licenses.
- Beer is to be sold for takeout; however, law provides for tables to eat and drink over a 20-minute period.
- All sales are carded with birthdates entered into register.
- Responsible Alcohol Management Program Training completed by Managers and staff.
