**MEETING MINUTES**

The committee met to review accomplishments for the year. Listed was a successful trash contract and transition to the new hauler. The new contract, however, does not include free toters nor a reward points program to encourage recycling as the previous contract did. But it does include new large blue recycling containers for residents which will be distributed in June. The larger containers should encourage an increase in volume of recycling materials.

Looking ahead, the committee discussed the need to reinforce and remind residents that due to the new law they can't place electronics like TV's curbside but they will need to drop them off at the York County Solid Waste Authority's site on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday of each month. Including this information on the recycling page of the township's newsletter might be a way to do that.

The committee also discussed work that can be done with that recycling page to make it more interesting to township readers. A possibility would be to change the arrangement of items on the page or perhaps use graphics to illustrate which items can and cannot be recycled.

The committee has scheduled the next meeting for September 10, 2013.
