



### Preparing Incident Command Stations

- Office of Emergency Management (OEM) is the lead agency for incident management including planning for the potential increased need of ICU beds, other medical equipment, and services. They handle escalating issues related to food, shelter and transportation and can be reached at 717-840-2990.
- OEM and County's Chief Health Strategist developed a dashboard that tracks bed capacity in our healthcare providers.



### Assisting at Risk Populations

- All 24/7 County Operations continue to run, including Youth Development Center, Prison, and 911.
- The Area Agency on Aging is partnering with Senior Centers to ensure older adults are receiving meals.
- The Veterans Affairs Office continues to support the need of our Veterans with e-signing options for benefits packages.
- York County Children Youth and Families continues to investigate allegations of child abuse.
- The York/Adams HealthChoices Management Unit and MH-IDD Program are offering telehealth options for those needing mental health services.
- The York/Adams Drug and Alcohol Commission is offering screening for drug and alcohol treatment telephonically.
- The Planning Commission is leading the partners to address the needs of the homeless, those living in emergency shelter and recovery houses, and others.



### Collaborating Partners

- Collaborating with our two largest Healthcare Partners, WellSpan and UPMC on many initiatives aimed at fighting the current COVID 19 Pandemic.
- Working alongside the York County Economic Alliance (YCEA) to develop the Prepared York website as a vital tool and resource for county residents, business owners and community at large.
