


Addendum:**Records requested:**

1. I would like to review all invoices and/or other documentation of all expenses paid by Springettsbury Township related to Pennsylvania Commonwealth Court Docket No. 1353 CD 2008 and York County Common Pleas Court docket 2007-SU-4577-Y08 (the Brenneman case).

2. I would like to review of all invoices and/or other documentation of all expenses paid by Springettsbury Township related to the Zoning Hearing Board hearing involving Kathleen Brenneman that preceded, and directly led to, the aforementioned court cases.

3. In lieu of reviewing all invoices/documentation, I will accept an electronic or paperbound accounting of all expenses paid by Springettsbury Township stemming from the aforementioned zoning hearing board case and subsequent court cases. I would request this accounting be broken down and totaled by the recipient of the funds.

The purpose of my request is to discover how much the township has paid to enforce the zoning officer's 2007 notice of violation against Kathleen Brenneman for operating a kennel in the R-7 zoning district where such use is not permitted.
