

Dear John:

The undersigned is executrix/administrator to the Estates of Bonnie L. & Kenneth R. Miller. Bonnie & Kenneth both passed away on August 4th, 2009.

As you may or may not be aware Kenneth R. Miller murdered his wife, Bonnie L. Miller and then committed suicide.

By way of this letter we are requesting that a copy of the policy provisions of his benefit plan be provided to our office. Please be sure that the information includes the following (in writing) along with any other information that may be pertinent to the plan.

1. Exact title of the plan; (example: qualified joint survivor pension, life pension, etc.)
2. Was the plan contributed to by the employer & employee and if so, the amounts that each contributed;
3. Was it a monthly plan?

We did request a copy of the policy provisions before from Fulton Financial in our letter to them dated 08/28/2009. We did not get a response to our letter and I was finally able to talk to Annette Hose on 09/29/2009, at which time we were informed that "due to IRS regulations regarding provisions of defined benefits plans an owner cannot name a beneficiary and by law the spouse is the beneficiary. Upon the death of the spouse any benefits cease." When I questioned if we could get a copy of this regulation, in writing, she told me to contact the IRS.

I did contact the IRS and in order for them to help me with this request they are requiring more information on the policy provisions, as I requested above.

We have talked with Tom Zimmerman & Betty at the township and have gotten bits and pieces of the above info. but again no one has ever provided anything in writing. Therefore, I am officially requesting a response, in writing, to this letter.

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
I reviewed the request with you by phone and sent an initial letter on October 29, 2009.
