Re: **RIGHT-TO-KNOW REQUEST – Purchasing Records**

Dear Carolina Barrios,

Thank you for writing to Springettsbury Township to request records pursuant to Pennsylvania's Right-to-Know Law ("RTKL"), 65 P.S. §§ 67.101 *et seq.*

On January 17, 2022, you requested:

"...for any and all purchasing records from Oct 19, 2021 12:00 AM to current. The request is limited to readily available records without physically copying, scanning or printing paper documents. The specific information requested from your record keeping system is:

1. Purchase order number. If purchase orders are not used a comparable substitute is acceptable
2. Purchase date
3. Line item details (Detailed description of the purchase)
4. Line item quantity
5. Line item price
6. Vendor ID number, name, address, contact person and their email address"

Your request is granted in part and denied in part as follows. The period of records is from October 19, 2021 through January 18. Please note there are 2 reports included with this response; they provide Purchase orders for 2021 and 2022.

- RTK-851 PO 10-19-2021 to 10-18-2022 Budget Year 2021
- RTK-851 PO 12-22-2021 to 01-18-2022 Budget Year 2022

Records related to your request are included with this response, sent via email to the provided email address.

Please note, although you have requested an “editable electronic document”, the Township has provided records in PDF format. The Right-to-Know Law states “A record being provided to a requestor shall be provided in the medium requested if it exists in that medium,” and the Township is providing you the documents in electronic medium, but not in a specified file format in accordance with several Office of Open Record Final Determinations.

- Specifically, *Bangs v Allegheny County*, Office of Open Records Final Determination, Docket No. AP 2015-2643 with additional determinations and text referenced:
 - “The RTKL does not define “medium;” however, the OOR has defined it “as the substance through which something is transmitted or carried, a ‘means,’ such as on paper or on a hard-drive or on a database or over the Internet.”
 - “The RTKL provides requestors with the right to inspect and duplicate. Duplication is a snapshot, a static record that cannot be altered or modified, in other words, a copy....It was provided in an electronic medium and there is no requirement to provide records in a manner that would subject them to alteration or manipulation.”
 - “Under the RTKL, ‘medium’ is a broad term, and ‘electronic medium’ encompasses all electronic formats.”
- *Cap v. Lehigh and Northampton Transp. Auth.*, OOR Dkt. AP 2013-0168, 2013 PA O.O.R.D. Lexis 112.
- *Acton v. Fort Cherry Sch. Dist.*, OOR Dkt. AP 2009-0926, 2009 PA O.O.R.D. Lexis 786, *aff'd*, No. 2010-719 (Wash. Com. Pl. July 26, 2011), *aff'd*, 38 A.3d 1092 (Pa. Commw. Ct. 2012), petition for allowance of appeal denied, 57 A.3d 72 (Pa. 2012).
- *Bowling v. Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency*, See OOR Dkt. AP 2009-0128, 2009 PA O.O.R.D. Lexis 607, *rev'd on other grounds*, *Bowling v. Office of Open Records*, 990 A.2D 813 (PA Commw. Ct. 2010), *aff'd*, 75 A.3d 453 (Pa. 2013)

Additionally, records that are exempt from disclosure by law have been withheld or redacted pursuant to the RTKL; no email addresses or phone numbers are included, and street addresses were removed, pursuant to the following sections of the RTKL.

Portions of the records provided have been redacted based on Pennsylvania’s Right to Know Law, Act 3 of 2008:

- Chapter 7, Section 706 Redaction
 - If an agency determines that a public record, legislative record or financial record contains information which is subject to access as well as information which is not subject to access, the agency’s response shall grant access to the information which is subject to access and deny access to the information which is not subject to access. If the information which is not subject to access is integral part of the public record, legislative record or financial record and cannot be separated, the agency shall redact from the record the information which is not subject to

access, and the response shall grant access to the information which is subject to access. The agency may not deny access to the record if the information which is not subject to access is able to be redacted.

- Chapter 7, Section 708(6) (i) A record containing all or part of a person's Social Security number, driver's license number, personal financial information, home cellular or personal telephone numbers; personal e-mail addresses; employee number or other confidential personal identification numbers.
- Additionally, based upon a Pennsylvania Supreme Court ruling (PSEA v Office of Open Records, 2016 Pa. LEXIS 2337), Commonwealth citizens have a constitutional right to privacy regarding their home addresses. Therefore, the record provided for purchase orders does not include address information since Commonwealth (PA) residents were included in the requested records. The Township is not able to collate personal or commercial information and therefore this information has been redacted.


The record is provided in the manner it exists, per Pennsylvania Right to Know Law, Act 3 of 2008, Section 705: Creation of record. When responding to a request for access, an agency shall not be required to create a record which does not currently exist or to compile, maintain, format, or organize a record in a manner in which the agency does not currently compile, maintain, format or organize the record.

You have a right to appeal this denial in writing to: Office of Open Records, 333 Market St., 16th Floor, Harrisburg, PA 17101-2234. Appeals can also be filed online at the Office of Open Records website, <https://www.openrecords.pa.gov>.

If you choose to file an appeal you must do so within 15 business days of the mailing date of the agency's response. See 65 P.S. § 67.1101. Please note that a copy of your original RTKL request, the agency's extension notice (if applicable), and this denial letter should be included when filing an appeal. More information about how to file an appeal under the RTKL is available at the Office of Open Records website, <https://www.openrecords.pa.gov>.
