1. CALL TO ORDER

SWOMLEY Chairman Mark Swomley called the Public Hearing to order at 6:45 p.m.

2. NEW BUSINESS

A. Transfer of Pennsylvania Restaurant Liquor License No. R-18069 from 34 N. Front Street, York Haven, PA to 17 Cinema Drive, York, PA (Marcello's East York, LLC)

PERRY Attorney Ron Perry presented the request to transfer a Liquor License into the township from York Haven. A completed application had been submitted and provided to the board. Attorney Perry noted that Marcello Mannino was present in the audience to respond to questions. He stated that Mr. Mannino had been operating restaurants in York County for 20 years and had been the owner of liquor licenses twice in the past, once in Springettsbury Township. There had never been any adverse incidents affiliated with his establishments. Mr. Mannino is the sole owner of the Limited Liability Company which will own the license once it is transferred and accepted by him. He offered to respond to questions.

SCHENCK Mr. Schenck asked what type of license it would be.

PERRY Attorney Perry responded that it is an R license, which applies to selling beer, liquor and wine. He noted that in the future they will be applying for an amusement permit, as well as a beer delivery permit. With a beer delivery permit an individual can order pizza and have a six pack of beer delivered as well. The practice is relatively new and the rules relating to it are very strict.

SCHENCK Mr. Schenck commented that those additional permits would not relate to this application.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT

SWOMLEY Chairman Swomley called for Public Comment.

Resident A resident noted that Marcello's makes good pizza; might as well have good beer.

PERRY Attorney Perry thanked the board for its consideration.

4. ADJOURNMENT
