

Parks & Recreation Board Meeting Minutes

The work session was conducted via Zoom, link to meeting was posted on the township website for public access.

In attendance at the meeting was Steve Wolf, Sean Georgi and Colin Lacey. There was no public attendance. The Recreation Board did not have any comments or communication to share this evening. With that the Rec Board addressed the Augustus Schaefer Park agenda item. Colin informed the Board that the park improvement project was awarded to York Excavating Company in the amount of \$275,767.52. The construction period will begin October 26th and operate until May 31, 2021.

The next item addressed regarded the Holiday Tree Lighting Event and its appropriateness to be held on Friday, November 20, 2020. Colin began by informing the Rec Board that both Central York School District and York Suburban School District have approved of their student's participation in the event. The schools recommended that social distancing must occur and masks must be worn by students and those in attendance. Colin also insisted that several other changes will be made to the program to aid in the efforts of social distancing. This year there will be no gathering around the tree due to the inability to physically distance and social distancing circles will be placed on the stage. Both Steve Wolf and Sean Georgi are in support of the event. Sean stated that the invite is outside, smaller scale and similar social groups that will be in attendance, compared to a summer concert where individuals are attending from different counties.

The last agenda item addressed at the meeting was the 2021 Sounds of Summer Concert Series. Colin informed the Rec Board that the series will operate from Sunday, June 6 to Sunday August 1, 2021. The Fireworks display will be held on Sunday, July 4th. With no further discussion, the meeting was adjourned.
