**MEETING MINUTES  
November 13, 2012**

The committee met with Penn Waste representative Ed Ward to discuss changes and features regarding recycling in the new contract. There will be some route changes beginning in January 2013 when the new contract takes effect. Some of the Friday pick up locations will now be done on Thursdays. Residents will be notified of those changes in a flyer that will be mailed to township residents. The flyer will also detail information that residents need to know about recycling such as what items are and are not acceptable for recycling, trash and recycling pickup options, and a calendar noting changes in pick up days due to holidays. New carts will be delivered beginning in the middle of December. Mr. Ward noted that Penn Waste will be working diligently to make sure that the transition to Penn Waste from York Waste runs as smoothly as possible for the township.

Penn Waste will be forwarding monthly trash reports and logs of customer complaints to the township. Mr. Ward said that Penn Waste will be focusing on recycling education with information for residents on the company's website and on Facebook, You Tube, etc. and that the company is constantly searching for more markets so that the list of accepted recyclable materials could be expanded in the future.

The committee is looking into a possible tour of Penn Waste's facilities for the next meeting date which is scheduled for January 8, 2013.
